Perfect Bound Books



What is perfect binding?

Perfect bound books look clean and professional. Perfect binding is a method of bookbinding where a flexible adhesive attaches a paper cover to the spine of the assembled pages. Ideal for show catalogs, portfolios, photo albums, small run comics, and self published artists books.

Perfect Bound Books take 5 business days to complete, whether you're getting 1 or 10.

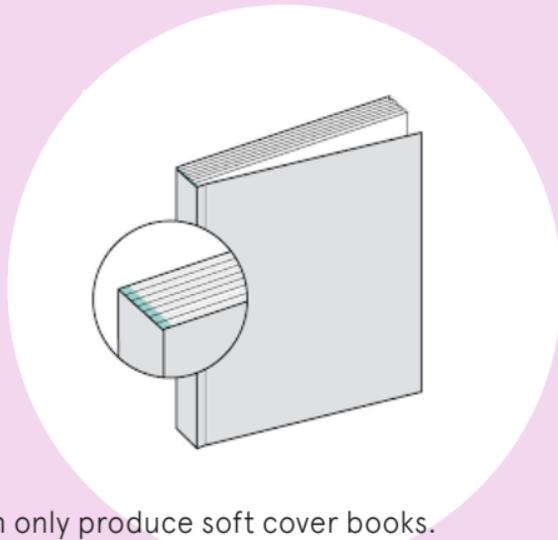
We have limited the number of books that can be ordered to 10 per month.

The perfect binding process is done all by hand and takes a considerable amount of production time which pulls staff away from their other duties.

We have posted recommendations on our website for local + online vendors that can accommodate the production of larger quantities.

BINDING LIMITATIONS + FINAL BOOK DIMENSIONS

LIMITS OF WHAT WE CAN BIND*	
Final Book Size	Max: 11" on the longest side Minimum: 4 inches
Max Spine Length	11"
Minimum # of pages in book	40 pages



* We can only produce soft cover books.
We cannot assist with hard cover bindings.

We do have a maximum and minimum size limitation for what we can bind successfully in our binding machine and with the sheets sizes available for the wrap around covers.

BINDING PARAMETERS + FINAL BOOK DIMENSIONS

There are two paper sizes we print the books on that will determine which product you will choose on our Digital Storefront.

The Perfect Bound Book category on our Digital Storefront consists of two products:

Small and Large.



Small

The final book size is SMALLER than 7.5"x10". Printed on 8.5"x11" sheets.

Large

The final book size is LARGER than 7.5"x10". Printed on 11"x17" sheets.

The **final size** of your book **plus** the required crop and bleed marks (they will add to your overall file size) will determine the sheet size it will be printed on.

The larger the sheet we need for printing your file, the more expensive your book will be.

It is in your best interest to determine the sheet size your book will be printed on before placing an order. This way you can budget for you project without surprises!

SMALL Perfect Bound Book

Your final book size is 7.5"x10" or smaller.

7.5"x10" is the largest size book you can make that still allows us to print on an 8.5x11 sheet of paper.

This size allows for the the crop and bleed marks in the final file to show up on a letter sized sheet.

Example:

If your book is 6"x6"

This book is smaller than the 7.5"x10" size for both sides so can be printed on 8.5"x11".

You would submit as the Small Perfect Bound Book.

LARGE Perfect Bound Book

Your final book is larger than 7.5"x10" on any of the sides.

This is a size that would need to be printed on the larger 11"x17" sheet size.

If you need your final book to be 8.5"x11" this book would be printed on an 11"x17" sheet and would be considered a LARGE Perfect Bound Book.



Example:

If your book is 8"x8"

This book is larger than the 7.5" size for one of the edges so you would submit for the Large Perfect Bound Book .

THINGS TO CONSIDER WITH PERFECT BOUND BOOKS

Cost

Perfect binding can be more expensive than other methods, especially for small print runs.

Books will not lay flat

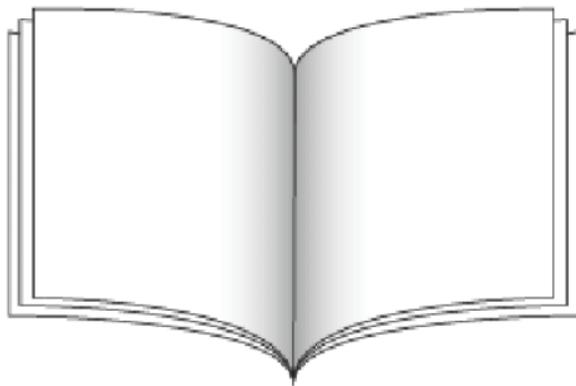
Because of the way the books are glued together they will not lay flat.

If you apply too much pressure to the spine, pages can break and fall out.

Content Lost in Gutter

The center of the book where the pages meet the spine is often obscured, making it hard to view images or text in this area.

Placing important images or text too close to the spine on a double-page spread can lead to content being lost in the book's "gutter".



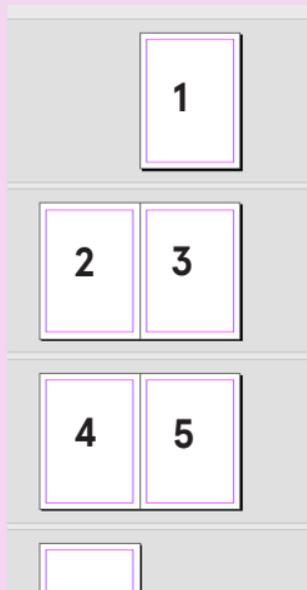
The gutter can also be problematic when you are placing an image or text across the center spine.

When an image or text covers a two-page spread, the inside 1/4" on both pages will be obscured. This amounts to approximately 1/2" in the center of the image or book.

FILE SET UP - INTERIOR FILE *AND* COVER FILE

For Perfect Bound Books you are required to submit 2 PDF's.

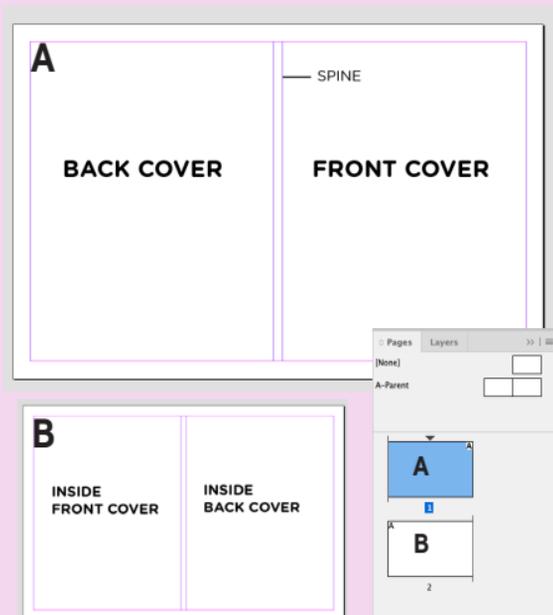
There will be two separate PDF files: one for the COVER (front cover, spine, back as one spread) and one for the INTERIOR pages (single pages in reading order).



←-----
Interior page file should be set up in the order the pages will be read.

Single pages - not spreads!

-----→
The cover file will include the *front cover, back cover* and *spine* as one page (A) and the *inside front cover, inside back cover* and the *spine* area as one page. (B)



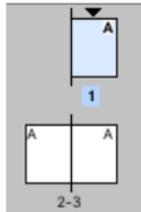
1- INTERIOR PAGES / BODY FILE

File > Document Setup >

Document Size should be the dimensions of your final book in inches. The body of your book must be single pages, not spreads.

Margin set to at least .25" on all sides

Bleed set to .125" on all sides



If you have the file set to **Facing Pages** the first page will be by itself at the top.

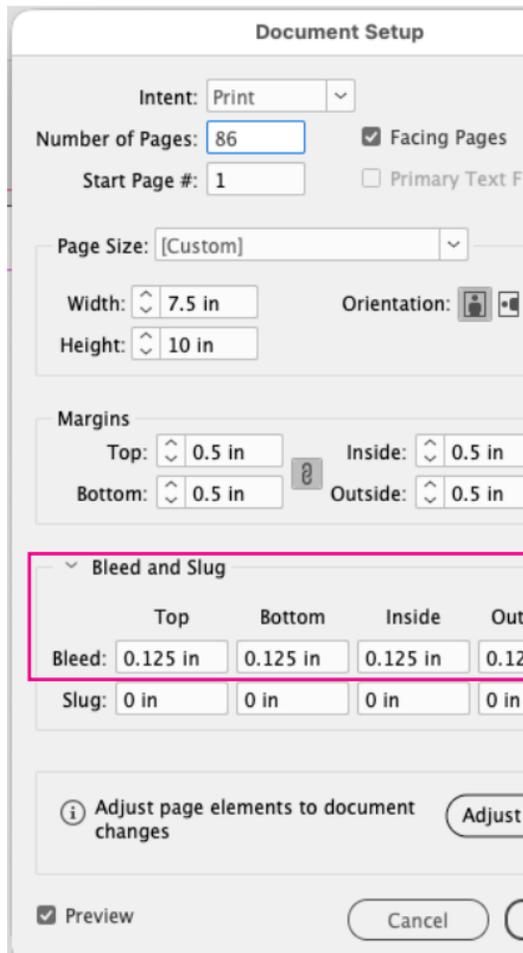
This is the first page of your body file. This is the page people will see when they open your book.

Bleed Line - content that goes "off the page" extend to this line and will be trimmed off allowing for full bleed images.

*If you need content to be full bleed then you will need to pull that content out to this line.

Cut Line - this is the actual physical edge of the page and your book. This is where we will cut.

Margin - important information should be inside this line.



SPINE CALCULATIONS

Refer to the table to estimate how wide the spine will be.

The number of **sheets** will be the total number of pages divided by 2.

60 pages = 30 sheets

This number will be added to the width dimension of your cover file.

Keep in mind this is just an estimate!

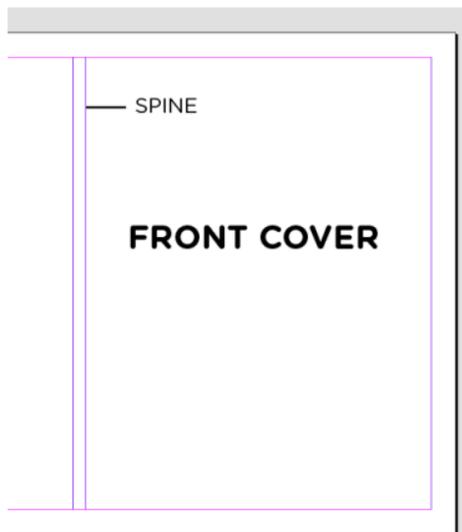
The dimensions of your spine will depend on the paper type you choose for your interior pages and the thickness of the paper stock.

We will do our best to adjust your cover file if needed. However, we may ask that you edit and resend your cover file once the binding process is underway.

If you want text on your spine, be sure to make it small enough to fit.

2- COVER FILE

File > New Document...

The page size is going to be the **height** of your final book and the **width** of your final book size. **X 2 plus the spine width.**

Width = Spine Width + (Page Width x 2)
Height = Book Height

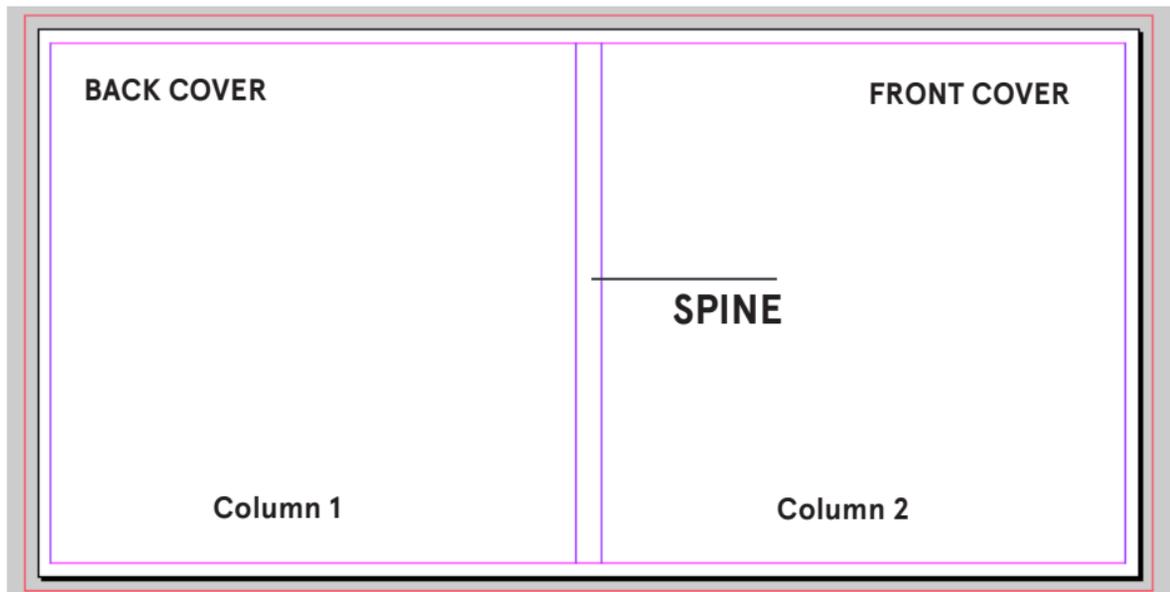

ADDING SPINE GUIDES

This is what your cover spread should look like.



Now you have guides for your spine!

→ The FRONT COVER will be on the RIGHT side of the file and the BACK COVER will be on the LEFT side of the file.

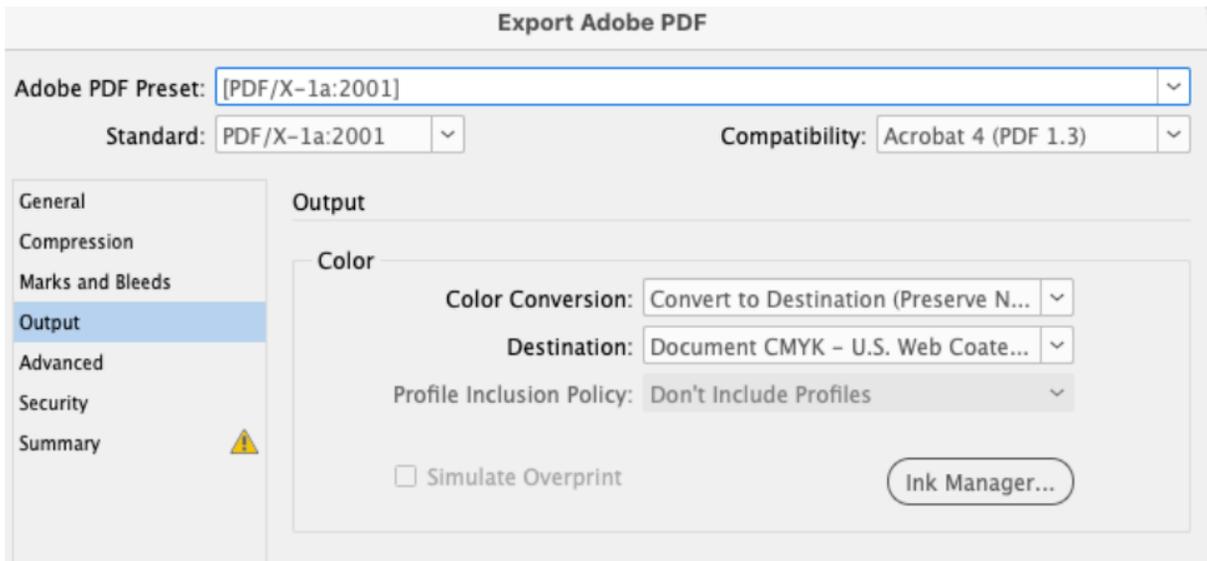

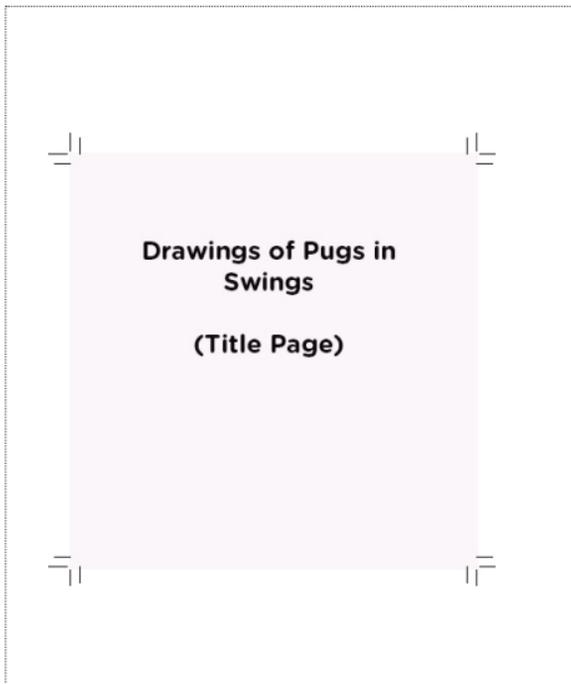

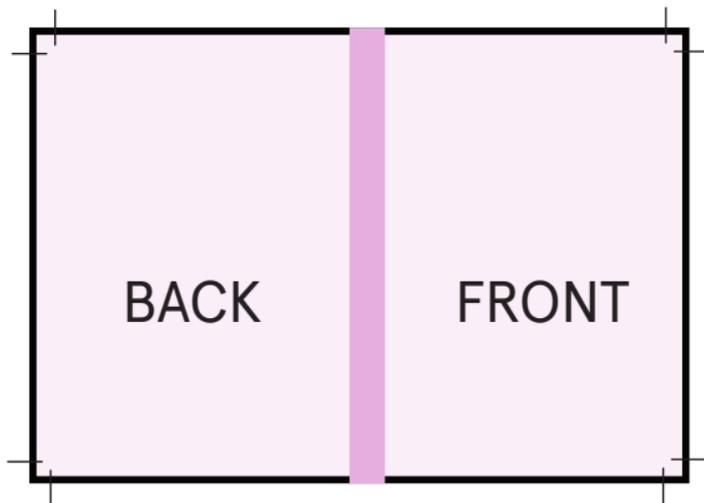
Here's what your two files should look like when you open them in Acrobat.

IMPORTANT: The Body.pdf should be individual pages, with crop marks on all sides. Colors or images that go to the edge of the page should extend beyond the crop marks to the bleed marks.

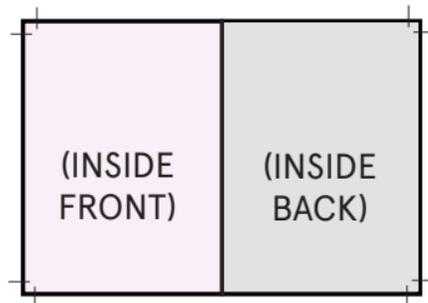

inside cover*

*If you want the inside of your cover to be something other than white, make it the second page of your cover file.

Unlike the first page of your cover file, the inside of the front cover is on the left and the inside of the back cover is on the right.
